

Graphite removes the hard to clean stains around the toilet bowl without the need to scrub with scrubbing pads. The product is simply applied with an applicator swab and allowed to stand for up to three minutes. This is sufficient time to completely remove lime, rust and other accumulated mineral deposits. It can be used for toilets, showers, bathtubs and urinals. It will not harm drains or pipes.

Directions for use

Test Graphite on a concealed area for possible discoloration of tinted fixtures. When applied to toilet bowl, lower water level first, pour approximately 1/2 cup Graphite in a plastic container and soak an applicator swab. Do not store in glass or metal containers. Apply Graphite with a swab on stained area. Allow to stand for 1-3 minutes maximum. Longer dwell times may cause dulling of glaze from finish. Rinse all exposed surfaces several times with fresh water.

DANGER HAZARD STATEMENTS

Wear protective gloves, protective clothing,
